



## Clothing and Accessory Packing List

### What You Should Bring to Summer Discovery

#### Clothing

- 2-3 pairs of jeans
- 2-5 pairs of shorts
- 6-10 short sleeve shirts/tee-shirts
- 1-2 long sleeve shirts
- 1-2 swimsuit(s)
- 8-10 pairs of socks
- 1-2 light sweaters or sweatshirts
- casual outfits (khakis, skirts, shirts)
- 1 warm jacket/raincoat
- 8-10 pairs of underwear
- 1-2 pairs of pajamas

#### Accessories

- bathrobe
- 1-2 beach towels/bath towels
- 10-20 hangers (may be purchased locally)
- laundry bag
- toiletry kit (soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, laundry detergent, washcloth, shampoo, conditioner, etc.)
- sunscreen
- sunglasses
- hat(s)
- watch
- belt(s)
- water bottle
- sleeping mask
- PLENTY of FACE MASKS (2-3 disposable per day or 5-6 washable cloth masks)
- Phone charger(s)

#### Footwear

- 2-3 pairs of sneakers
- 1-2 pairs of sandals/flip flops/shower shoes

#### Linens/Towels

Summer Discovery may supply sheets, a pillow, a blanket, and towels based on location.

#### Laundry Facilities

Summer Discovery will provide students with the contact information for a laundry service. Students are responsible for paying for this service.

#### Spending Money

Students must have an ATM or Debit Card for use at local ATM's to obtain spending money. Please advise your bank that the card holder will be traveling to Michigan. As a guide, we recommend students have available approximately \$100 to \$150 available per week, to cover snacks, and souvenirs.

#### Packing Light and Purchasing Items After Arriving on Campus

Please note that residence halls have limited closet and dresser space and we suggest you pack light. All students will have the opportunity to purchase additional items locally on campus.

#### Luggage

We recommend that you bring one or two pieces of luggage with wheels for easy transport. Students must claim and carry their luggage to/from our airport transfer vehicles and to/from their rooms.



### **Airline Baggage Fees**

Most airlines charge fees for any checked bags (varies by airline) and most airlines now charge for bags that are over 50lbs (varies by airline); you are responsible for paying for all baggage fees at time of airport check-in. Please check your airline's website for their baggage charges.

### **Classroom Supplies**

Bring a notebook, pencil, and pens with you for the first day of class. Additional supplies may be purchased in town bookstores. Laptop computers are strongly encouraged. Please bring chargers for any accessories you will be using.

**DO NOT BRING:** Tobacco products, vaping instruments, alcohol, illegal drugs, and/or paraphernalia\*. Air conditioners, refrigerators, microwaves, toaster ovens, TVs, bicycles, roller blades, hover boards, skate boards, drones. Weapons of any kind, including Swiss Army Knives, fireworks, combustible materials, etc.\*
